### Talking Points:

- 130,000 veterans need this cemetery
- Close to town location – Kolb/Valencia
- 6 miles from I-10
- Easy access – Old Vail Road is right beside the property
- Land is flat with no drainage problems
- 100 acres with 3,600 graves/acre, that is 360,000 sites
- Pima County will donate that acreage FREE
- Largest Arizona county without a veterans cemetery
- Patriotic area near Davis-Monthan Airbase and Pima Air Museum
- Widows do not have to drive long distances to visit their veteran
- Will add to the beauty of the area
- Economically viable – free land and located on an existing road
- Perfect resting place
- 100 acres in the vicinity would cost about \$5 million. Ours is FREE
- The following groups are in support: Arizona Veterans Affairs, the VFW, DAV, the American Legion, the Purple Heart Group, the Korean War Veterans, Tucson Mayor, the Arizona Governor, the State Legislature, and, of course, Pima County, Davis-Monthan and 130,000 veterans.
