**PIMA COUNTY HOUSING COMMISSION**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Commission is to increase the amount of housing in Pima County that is affordable to low and median income families, and to oversee and assure public accountability for Pima County Housing Bond Funds.

The Commission will develop a Pima County Affordable Housing Strategy, for approval by the Board of Supervisors, and promote collaborative housing projects with for-profit and non-profit housing providers.

The Commission will review and recommend uses of Pima County Housing Bond funds and annually report to the Board of Supervisors on the status of Housing Bond Funds, the Housing Trust Fund and the affordable housing programs.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Board of Supervisors action, November 16, 2004.

**NUMBER OF MEMBERS:** 11 Members: Ten (10) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors and One (1) appointed by the County Administrator.

**APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION:** Supervisor Appointment unrestricted by district.

**APPOINTMENT TERM:** Four years.

**NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER YEAR:** Minimum of 4 meetings per year.

**STANDARD MEETING TIME:** 3:00 - 5:00 p.m.

**STANDARD MEETING DAY:** Third Monday of each month
