**PIMA COUNTY SPORTS AND TOURISM AUTHORITY**

**TERMINATION UNDER SUNSET LAW:** The Authority is intended to be an interim activity, and shall be sunsetted when legislation is enacted by the Arizona Legislature to create an authority similar to the Arizona Sports and Tourism Authority operating within Maricopa County.

**PURPOSE:** Pima County desires to establish a sports and tourism authority pursuant to A.R.S. §11-701 in order to retain Major League Baseball Spring Training in Pima County and to enhance amateur youth sports in Pima County.

**AUTHORIZATION:** P.C. Resolution No. 2008-61, establishing the Pima County Sports and Tourism Authority. BOS action, 4-1-08.

**NUMBER OF MEMBERS:** The Authority shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of (15) fifteen members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Membership shall broadly represent the sports and tourism industry, including the resort, hotel and motel industry; the restaurant industry; amateur youth sports; Major League Baseball spring training; the Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Alliance; the Tucson Metropolitan Convention and Visitors Bureau; Tucson Regional Economic Opportunities, Inc.; the athletic directors or their designees from the University of Arizona and Pima Community College; and public high schools athletics within Pima County.

**APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION:** Supervisor Appointment unrestricted by district.

**APPOINTMENT TERM:** Eight members shall serve two-year terms; and Seven members shall serve four-year terms.
