**PIMA COUNTY/TUCSON COMMISSION ON  
ADDICTION, PREVENTION AND TREATMENT**

**PURPOSE:** The Commission is to provide advice and make recommendations with respect to the social, financial and health consequences of addiction in Pima County.

**AUTHORIZATION:** P.C. Resolution No. 2001-244 and Resolution No. 2002-322, extends evaluation period to September 30, 2008.

P.C. Resolution No. 2006-297, amending Resolution No. 2001-244, increasing the number of ex-officio members to eight.

**MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION:** The Commission shall be composed of no more than nineteen (19) members and eight (8) ex-officio members, all of whom shall be residents of Pima County and shall be knowledgeable about addiction, prevention, and treatment issues and concerns. Members shall be jointly appointed by the Pima County Board of Supervisors and the City of Tucson Mayor and Council, shall serve at the will of both bodies without compensation and are subject to reappointment by the Board and Council. Membership shall include representatives of private business, law-related professions, healthcare, prevention and treatment organizations and providers and recovering addicts or family members of recovering addicts.
