Any person aggrieved in any manner by a decision of a Board of Adjustment may appeal to the Superior Court pursuant to A.R.S. §11-807(D) and Pima County Code §18.93.070.

AUTHORIZATION: A.R.S. §11-807 and Pima County Code Chapter 18.93.
