Membership should include representatives from each of the following organizations/ governments: Southern Arizona Veterinary Medical Association; Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals; The Humane Society of Tucson; The Tucson Kennel Club; Animal Welfare Coalition; Pima County Board of Health; Animal Defense League of Arizona; Foundation for Animals at Risk; People for Animals in the Prevention of Cruelty and Neglect; City of Tucson; a Public Educator; a resident of Pima County, who needs and uses the assistance of a certified service dog, as representative of the Disabled Community; and the Manager of the Pima Animal Care Center shall serve as an ex-officio member.
