**PURPOSE:** The historic district advisory board assists the Planning and Zoning Commission in designating the boundaries of the proposed district, selecting the sites, structures and landscapes which are to be designated as historic, and upon historic designation of the district, reviews applications for building permits, maintains an inventory record, and keeps residents advised.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Pima County Zoning Code Section 18.63.060

**APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION:** Supervisor Appointment unrestricted by district

**NUMBER OF MEMBERS:** 9, of which 1/3 shall be residents of the district, 1/3 shall be real property owners of the district, and 1/3 shall have special qualifications in architecture, history, archaeology, etc.

**APPOINTMENT TERM:** Appointed by the Board of Supervisors and serve at the will of the Board of Supervisors.

**NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER YEAR:** 12 (and additional, as needed)
