AUTHORIZATION: Board action 7-01-03, to establish a 19 member committee. P.C. Ordinance No. 2004-16, relating to revenue and finance; amending the Pima County Code, Chapter 3.06, Bonding Disclosure, Accountability and Implementation. Board action 4-6-04.

Board action 11-14-06, to increase membership from 19 to 25 members.

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION: (25) Twenty-five Members: 3 appointed by each Board member; 3 appointed by the County Administrator; 1 appointed by the Pascua Yaqui Tribe; 1 appointed by the Tohono O'Odham Nation; 1 appointed by the City of Tucson; 1 appointed by the City of South Tucson; 1 appointed by the Town of Marana; 1 appointed by the Town of Oro Valley; and 1 appointed by the Town of Sahuarita.
