**COUNTY ATTORNEY INVESTIGATORS
LOCAL RETIREMENT BOARD**

PURPOSE: To review and recommend retirement benefits for public safety retirement members with respect to full-time, paid Pima County Attorney's Office investigators, who are certified peace officers and regularly assigned to hazardous duty.

AUTHORIZATION: A.R.S. §38-847; Pima County Resolution No. 1995-69; Joinder Agreement with the Arizona Public Safety Personnel Retirement System (September 9, 1993).

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION: One member who shall be the Chairman of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, or his designee who shall be approved by the Board of Supervisors, to serve as chairman.

Two members who shall be elected by secret ballot by members employed in the Pima County Attorney's Office as Peace Officer Investigators currently certified by AZ POST and who are eligible for participation in the Public Safety Retirement System.

Two members who shall be citizens appointed by the Chairman of the Pima County Board of Supervisors with the approval of the Board of Supervisors. [One Citizen shall be the Chairman of the Pima County Merit System Commission.]
