COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY BOARD

PURPOSE: To serve as the advisory board regarding Community Services programs.

AUTHORIZATION: Community Services Block Grant Act, Subtitle B and Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 1980-166.

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION: 15 members; 5 appointed by the Board of Supervisors, one from each supervisorial district. Five are representatives of the poor, chosen by voting procedures handled by the Community Action Agency staff. Five are representatives of the private sector; these appointments are handled by the Community Action Agency.

APPOINTMENT TERM: The term of the 5 members appointed by the Board of Supervisors is at the discretion of the supervisor, and these members may serve as long as supervisors are in office. Terms are normally for one-year. Reappointments, in accordance with the bylaws, must be made each year in June.

Terms for the remaining 10 positions on the CAAB are normally two-year appointments.

NOTE: State regulations specify that seats on the CAAB may remain vacant only three months.
