**CORRECTIONS OFFICER RETIREMENT BOARD**

**PURPOSE:** To review and recommend retirement benefits for corrections officer retirement members.

**AUTHORIZATION:** A.R.S. §38-893.

**NUMBER OF MEMBERS:** 5, consisting of the chief elected official (Chairman, Board of Supervisors, or his designee who is approved by the Board of Supervisors), two members who are elected by secret ballot by members employed by Pima County in a designated position which is defined as a county detention officer or a non-uniformed employee of the Sheriff's Department whose primary duties require direct contact with inmates, and two citizens, one of whom is the head of the merit system and one of whom is appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors with the approval of the Board of Supervisors.
