

**PIMA COUNTY
BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**

ELECTRICAL CODE COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To review the National Electrical Code and to recommend regional Electrical Codes to the Board of Supervisors from the adopted National Code Standards (National Electric Code).

AUTHORIZATION: The Committee is authorized indirectly by A.R.S. §11-862 which holds that building codes adopted by the largest city within the county and the county codes will "at all times be substantially uniform." The statute also provides for code adoption in the same manner as for zoning ordinances, which require public hearings. The joint city/county electrical code committee provides for regional code review, public hearing, and technical review. This committee is also governed by the rules, regulations and bylaws outlined in Resolution No. 1988-17, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on January 26, 1988.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: a minimum of 7, a joint committee approved by both the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor/City Council. The number of members for the committee is established by the committee's rules and regulations. The building officials from the City and County (or their designees) serve as ex-officio members.

APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION: Joint Appointment

APPOINTMENT TERM: 3 Years. The appointment term is established by committee rules and regulations. For reappointments or to fill vacancies, the committee requests nominations from professional organizations in the electrical field. The building officials of the City and County then narrow down that list to one for recommendation to the Board of Supervisors and Mayor/City Council.

NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER YEAR: Code review for new codes adoption shall be held at regular meetings, held no less than monthly during code review, and at least annually thereafter.
