PURPOSE: To provide assistance in the study of flood control, floodplain management regulation and drainage needs of the District; advises and makes recommendations to the Board of Supervisors.

AUTHORIZATION: A.R.S. §48-3611 - Board, on the interpretation by the County Attorney's Office, viewed the statute as permissive, allowing the Board the flexibility on establishing the Committee and its composition.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: 12 members: 5 appointed by the Board of Supervisors (1 per district); 3 members representing the City of Tucson; and 4 members representing the City of South Tucson, the Town of Marana, the Town of Oro Valley and the Town of Sahuarita. Each member has voting privileges on the Committee.
