AUTHORIZATION: Pima County Ordinance No. 1995-90; and Pima County Resolution No. 1995-262; Joint - City/County.

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION: 23 members, of which 10 shall represent Pima County, 12 the City of Tucson, and 1 the City of South Tucson. The membership of the Commission shall not be employees of the County, City of Tucson or City of South Tucson.
