

**PIMA COUNTY
BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**

MECHANICAL/PLUMBING CODE COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To review and recommend local amendments to the International Mechanical/Plumbing and related codes, and to serve as a standing committee between code review. This joint County/City committee provides for regional code review, public hearing, and technical review.

AUTHORIZATION: The Committee is authorized indirectly by A.R.S. §11-862 which holds that an advisory body will determine the suitability of alternative materials and construction. Interpretation of adopted Codes will be relegated to the Building Codes Board of Appeals. This committee is also governed by the rules, regulations and bylaws outlined in Resolution No. 2006-92, amending Resolution No. 1988-17, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 18, 2006.

APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION: Joint City/County Appointment.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: A minimum of five and maximum of seven. This joint committee is approved by both the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor/City Council. The composition of the committee members is outlined in A.R.S. §11-862. The Building Officials from the County and City (or their designees) serve as ex-officio members.

APPOINTMENT TERM: Staggered terms of one to four years. The appointment term is established by committee rules and regulations. For reappointments or to fill vacancies, the committee requests nominations from professional organizations in the mechanical/plumbing field. The Building Officials of the County and City then narrow down that list for recommendation to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor/City Council.
