PURPOSE: The Pima County Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to appropriate funds each year for an Outside Agency Social Services Program which will assist local non-profit agencies to provide human service programs in the County.

AUTHORIZATION: Board of Supervisors action, January 28, 1992, established committee and membership.

Board of Supervisors action, April 18, 2006, to increase the voting membership by changing the County Administrator's Appointee from ex-officio, non-voting member status to voting member status; amending Committee By Laws, with four or more members constituting a quorum for the transaction of business.

APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION: Supervisor Appointment - unrestricted by district

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: Six (6) members: Five (5) appointed by the Board of Supervisors and one (1) appointed by the County Administrator. County staff is not allowed to serve on the Committee.

APPOINTMENT TERM: No term expiration. Members serve at the discretion of the appointing Supervisor/County Administrator.
