PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

PURPOSE: To hear and make recommendations on rezoning cases and amendments to the Pima County Zoning Ordinance. To hear and make recommendations on area and neighborhood plans and many other planning matters.

AUTHORIZATION: A.R.S. §11-803 and Pima County Zoning Ordinance

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: 10 members: Two members shall be appointed from each of the five supervisorial districts of the county by the supervisor representing the district, and members shall be residents of the district from which they are appointed.

APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION: Statutory District Appointment

APPOINTMENT TERM: 4 Years staggered terms, except for those initially appointed. Of those members initially appointed, five members shall be appointed to a two year term and five members shall be appointed to a four year term. Thereafter, each term shall be four years. If a vacancy occurs otherwise than by expiration of term, it shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term. Members of the commission may be removed by the board for cause.

NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER YEAR: 12 minimum; also special study meetings.

STANDARD MEETING TIME: 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. study session, 9:00 a.m. regular public hearings.
