

**PIMA COUNTY
BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

PURPOSE: To hear and make recommendations on rezoning cases and amendments to the Pima County Zoning Ordinance. To hear and make recommendations on area and neighborhood plans and many other planning matters.

AUTHORIZATION: A.R.S. §11-803 and Pima County Zoning Ordinance

NUMBER OF MEMBERS: 10 members: In the counties having five supervisorial districts, the county planning and zoning commission shall consist of ten members who shall be qualified electors of the county. Two members shall be appointed from each supervisorial district by the supervisor from that district and, if the district contains at least sixty per cent incorporated area, both members may be residents of the incorporated area. If the district is less than sixty per cent incorporated, one member may be a resident from the incorporated area but at least one member shall be a resident of the unincorporated area. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation except for reasonable travel expenses.

APPOINTMENT DESIGNATION: Statutory District Appointment

APPOINTMENT TERM: 4 Years staggered terms, except for those initially appointed. Of those members initially appointed, five members shall be appointed to a two year term and five members shall be appointed to a four year term. Thereafter, each term shall be four years. If a vacancy occurs otherwise than by expiration of term, it shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term. Members of the commission may be removed by the board for cause.

NUMBER OF MEETINGS PER YEAR: 12 minimum; also special study meetings.
