MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION: 20 members - (5) The Board of Supervisors shall each appoint one member. (7) The Mayor and each Council Member shall appoint one member. (8) The Pima County/Tucson Women's Commission, by a majority vote of its members, shall appoint eight members of the Commission.

APPOINTMENT TERM:

- The terms of the 5 members appointed by each Supervisor are coterminous with their terms of office or until their successors on the Commission are appointed.
- The terms of the 7 members appointed by the Mayor and Council members are coterminous with their terms of office or until their successors on the Commission are appointed.
- The terms of the 8 seats appointed by the Commission shall be for four (4) years. The Board of Supervisors and the Mayor and Council will ratify appointments made by the Pima County/Tucson Women's Commission.
