Pursuant to the provisions of Title 17 of the Pima County Code 17.12.240, Pima County Department of Environmental Quality, (PDEQ) has determined that the use of the generators as described in your letter received December 6, 2011 qualify as temporary and would therefore qualify as a facility change without a permit revision.

There will be no requirement to permit the generators provided that they are not onsite for more than 12 consecutive months. Should they be onsite at the time the final permit is issued you are required to notify PDEQ and discuss permitting options at that time.
