PLAN REVIEW SUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

Water Project Plans

1. Submit 2 Folded sets of Water Plans signed by the water utility and fire department. (Note: Sewer and water separation must be shown on construction plans)
2. Submit 4 Folded sets of Water Plans if PDEQ is performing microbiological sampling/pressure testing.
3. Submit **5** Folded sets of Water Plans signed by the water utility and fire department for **Oro Valley Water Utility**.
4. Submit **6** Folded sets of Water Plans signed by the water utility and fire department for **Marana Municipal Water System and Vail Water Company**.
5. Submit **8** Folded sets of Water Plans signed by the water utility and fire department for **Rancho Sahuarita Water Utility**.
6. Two Approval to Construct Water Project applications.
7. Check for \$ **500.00** made payable to PDEQ for **Water Line Extension**.
8. Check for \$**1000.00** made payable to PDEQ for **Storage Tanks**.
9. Check for \$**1000.00** made payable to PDEQ for **Pumps/Booster Stations/Pressure Tanks**.
10. Check for \$**1000.00** made payable to PDEQ for **New Water Sources**.
11. Check for \$ **150.00 per site visit for PDEQ to perform microbiological sampling or pressure testing**.
12. **For projects with more than one of these facilities, the fees are cumulative.**
13. Design Report, include Hydraulic Modeling.
14. A letter from the City of Tucson Water Department or Oro Valley Water Utility stating that required storage and 20-psi will be maintained under all conditions of flow Pursuant to A.A.C. R18-4-502 and R18-4-503 will suffice in lieu of hydraulic modeling report. This must be based on the results of hydraulic modeling, which may be requested by the department.
15. Designs and plans must be based on Arizona Administrative Code R18-4 and Engineering Bulletin No. 10, Guidelines for the Construction of Water Systems

*Final Inspection and "AS-BUILTS" shall be performed by an Arizona Registered Engineer.
