Dear Tire Customer;

Pima County Department of Environmental Quality, Solid Waste Management Division, has developed a new "Annual Waste Tire Generator Registration Form" and "Waste Tire Disposal Manifest" for use by retailers for acceptance of their tires at the Ina Road Waste Tire Collection Site located at 5301 West Ina Road, Tucson, AZ. Effective January 1, 2007, and each January 1 thereafter, each generator must register with the Ina Road Waste Tire Collection Site.

The Arizona Revised Statutes §44-1302 allows the County to refuse to accept waste tires and may impose a tire tipping fee if the seller is not **preregistered** with the collection site. To **preregister** with Pima County Solid Waste Management Division, Ina Road Waste Tire Collection Site, please complete the attached registration form and mail with your previous quarter TR-1 form to 5301 W. Ina Road, prior to December 15, 2006. Sellers not preregistered and loads not accompanied by the proper manifest form will be rejected. Loads from unregistered sources will require the tipping fee. Loads from tire generators who have not provided the TR-1 form will be charged the tipping fee. This fee is non-refundable. Pima County Code, Chapter 13.40 Solid Waste, including Ordinance #2003-98 Fee Schedule, are attached for your reference.

The new "Waste Tire Disposal Manifest" and "Annual Waste Tire Generator Registration Form" are attached and may be copied for your use. The forms are also available on the Pima County Department of Environmental Quality website: www.deq.pima.gov. **Original signatures in blue ink are required on each manifest. Manifests with copied signatures will be rejected.**

The Ina Road Waste Tire Collection Site accepts waste tires **from Pima County** residents and businesses only. Once tires have entered the Pima County Waste Tire Collection Site they **cannot** be removed.
