Please prepare three fiscal year 2009/10 budget scenarios for the Graffiti Abatement Program - the first with a 25 percent reduction of funding, the second with a 50 percent reduction, and finally, program elimination.

The question that needs to be answered relates to ongoing contractual commitments and if there are any that require any form of funding continuation until contract expiration.

I would appreciate receiving these three budget reduction scenarios for the Graffiti Abatement Program.
