Through our provider network, you will receive a complete refractive eye examination for a copayment of \$15, once every 12 months based on the date of your last exam. There is no coverage for routine eye exams out of network.

2. Don't be confused, you DON'T have Spectera. This eye exam benefit is included as part of your medical plan.
3. This plan does not include coverage for frames and lenses. However, you can access discounts for frames and lenses at www.healthallies.com.

Although these cards do not guarantee benefits, you may present them to your vision care provider to communicate important vision plan information. These reference cards are not required to visit a vision provider.

How to Use Your Vision Care Benefits

Step 1. Review your Customized Benefits

Carefully review your customized benefits to determine your program design and applicable copays. A copy of your benefits brochure may be obtained from the Pima County Employee Benefits website, <http://www.pima.gov/hr/EmployeeBenefits/> or you can access our Web site, www.myuhc.com, to obtain specifics about your vision benefits.

Step 2. Find a Conveniently-Located Provider

You may easily locate providers by logging on to www.myuhc.com and select "Find a Physician" in the Links and Tools section. You may also call toll-free 1.866.314.0335 to reach UnitedHealthcare's Customer Service Department.

Step 3. Schedule Your Appointment

Once a provider is chosen, simply call the provider directly to schedule your appointment. Provide your member identification number and identify yourself as having vision coverage through your UnitedHealthcare medical plan.

Step 4. Receive Your Eye Exam

The network provider, a state-licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist, will perform a complete eye examination, which includes a case history of the patient, an examination for eye pathology and abnormalities, visual analysis (refraction), confrontation visual fields testing, condition diagnosis, and prescription determination.

Step 5. Provider Claim
