There is no coverage for routine eye exams out of network.

Eye examinations billed to UnitedHealthcare with a medical diagnosis are covered as any other medical or pharmacy service provided on your plan. If you have not met your deductible, you will be responsible to pay for the exam at the full UnitedHealthcare discounted rate.

3. This plan does not include coverage for frames and lenses. However, you can access discounts for frames and lenses at www.healthallies.com.
