SUMMARY: Performs semi-skilled repair, labor and maintenance tasks in support of trades workers in public works projects and leads unskilled workers.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES: (Work assignments may vary depending on the department's needs and will be communicated to the applicant or incumbent by the supervisor.)

Performs miscellaneous semi-skilled repair, labor, and maintenance work;
Operates a pick-up or small dump truck, tamper, jackhammer, chain saw, or similar equipment;
Installs and maintains signs, signposts, guardrails, cattle guards, and fencing;
Lays rock;
Builds retaining walls and aprons and installs culverts, sewer lines, and manholes;
Patches pavement using concrete or oil and chips;
Mixes and sprays herbicides for weed control;
Picks up trash and keeps trash area clean;
Assists with traffic control;
Transports fuels and lubricants and parts for heavy construction and maintenance equipment and changes tires on equipment in the field;
Tasks may include simple painting, tree trimming, grass mowing, pest control, and other miscellaneous tasks;
Makes minor repairs to mechanical components at Wastewater treatment facility;
Performs simple tests on wastewater;
Makes simple mathematical calculations;
Leads other employees.

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS:

Knowledge of:

- safety practices to be used on the job;
- the practices, tools, and equipment used in maintenance and repair of roads, grounds, and facilities;
- the practices, tools, and equipment used in wastewater treatment work.

Skill in:

- performing heavy manual labor for extended periods of time, often under unfavorable weather conditions;
- following verbal and written instructions;
- making minor mechanical repairs
- performing simple wastewater testing procedures and making simple mathematical calculations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: **EITHER:**

(1) One year of experience in manual labor in a construction, grounds maintenance or public works environment.

OR:

(2) Six months of experience with Pima County as a Laborer.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Licenses and Certificates: Possession of a valid Class D Arizona Driver's License is required for some positions at time of appointment.

This class specification is intended to indicate the basic nature of positions allocated to the class and examples of typical duties that may be assigned. It does not imply that all positions within the class perform all of the duties listed, nor does it necessarily list all possible duties that may be assigned.
