Title: YOUTH WORKER

SUMMARY: Performs routine tasks for Pima County departments or other public or private sector organizations according to detailed instructions. Assignments are checked for accuracy, adherence to instructions and rate of performance.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES: (Work assignments may vary depending on the organization's needs and will be communicated to the applicant or incumbent by the supervisor.)

Positions within this classification will perform various tasks as assigned by the organization for which the incumbent is assigned.

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS:

Knowledge of:

- procedures and techniques for accomplishing assigned duties.

Skill in:

- performing assigned duties.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

**THIS IS A TESTED CLASSIFICATION.** To be considered for this classification, all applicants must pass appropriate Pima County written/performance tests administered by Pima County Community and Economic Development (PCCED), One-Stop.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Special Notice Items: All positions are for youth ages 14-21. Work hours vary between 20-40 hours per week. Some positions require working outdoors in heat, cold or rain or in confined areas. Employees will be provided protective clothing, sunscreen, water and safety training as deemed appropriate by the sponsoring department.

Physical/Sensory Requirements: Physical and sensory abilities will be determined by position.

It does not imply that all positions within the classification perform all of the duties listed, nor does it necessarily list all possible duties that may be assigned.
