
Fireworks and soccer at Kino Sports Complex on July 4

Head to Kino Sports Complex on the Fourth of July for fireworks and catch soccer fever!

Watch FC Tucson take on Albuquerque Sol FC and get a glimpse of what makes our local soccer team the top team in the Mountain Division and Premier Development League nationwide.

The match will kick off at 7:30 p.m. The 4th of July Blast presented by CenturyLink is scheduled to begin roughly 30 minutes after the game concludes.

"We want this to be the biggest, loudest and most electric crowd we've ever had at an FC Tucson match," the FC Tucson ownership group said in a joint statement. "We expect to set a club record for the highest attendance in our young history and then we want to celebrate the world's greatest sport in a World Cup year with a spectacular display during the match and the afterward."



The fireworks are just one of two displays happening in the Tucson area. Because of the fireworks, parking in the immediate area of the stadium will be severely limited. Fans are encouraged to arrive early, park on the south side of Kino Sports Complex, and walk over the Ajo Way bridge to get to North Stadium.

If you can't wait, you can catch FC Tucson at home against the Ventura County Fusion at 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, June 21.
