**Get discount tickets this week only  
to the Great Tucson Beer Festival in September**

Where can you quench your thirst and support a great nonprofit organization that delivers news and information to people who cannot read print because they have a disability?

At the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Great Tucson Beer Festival on Saturday, Sept. 27, at Kino Veterans Memorial Stadium.

And this week, for two days only, you can buy discount tickets that will also get you in the door earlier.

On Friday and Saturday, June 27-28, you can buy beer festival tickets for \$35 – \$10 off the regular \$45 ticket price – at Plaza Liquors, 2642 N. Campbell Ave.; at both Thunder Canyon Brewery locations: 7401 N. La Cholla Blvd., and 220 E. Broadway; and online at [www.azbeer.com](http://www.azbeer.com). Discount ticket holders will be able to get into the festival at 5:30 p.m. instead of 6.



V.I.P. tickets will also be discounted by \$10 on June 27-28 but will only be available online at [www.azbeer.com](http://www.azbeer.com). V.I.P tickets will be \$70 instead of \$80 and will allow an early entry of 5 p.m.

The Great Tucson Beer Festival is one of three held annually around the state to raise funds for Sun Sounds of Arizona, which has made it possible since 1979 for eligible listeners to hear daily newspapers, grocery ads, death notices, and other printed news at no cost to them.

In addition to dozens of different beers, festival goers ages 21 and older can enjoy snacks and food samples, music, horseshoes and other games – all for the price of admission.
