Learn metalworking techniques at your own pace. Fabricate beautiful jewelry and/or small functional pieces out of sterling silver, copper, stones, and found objects. All but the first project will be your choice. Receive plenty of individual instruction. Large tools and equipment are available for your use. You will need to purchase your own small hand tools and supplies which will be discussed at the first class meeting. The cost will vary depending on your individual projects. A \$15 initial materials fee is to be paid to the instructor at your first class.

Intro to Metal Clays

Students will be introduced to silver and bronze jewelry clays. Course will introduce basic techniques for forming jewelry items that are 99% pure metal after firing. Slab forming, molding, stamping, and finishing techniques will be taught. Both torch and kiln firing techniques will be used (equipment included in class fee). Classes are suitable for those with no experience with metal clays or jewelry making, and are geared for beginners. Basic tools will be provided; a \$15 materials fee will be payable to instructor on the first day of class. Students must supply their own clays. Class limited to 6 people per session. No class November 11. Make-up classes will be available.
