KNOW THE RULES

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:

- Possession of alcohol.
- Fishing and hunting.
- Boating, wading, and swimming.
- Bicycles, skating, and scooters.
- Unleashed dogs.
- Horses and vehicles.
- Kites and motorized toys.
- Pop-up shade canopies, jumping castles, piñatas, and balloons.
- Loud music.
- Organized sports such as football, baseball, and volleyball.
- Activities requiring staked nets or posts.
- Metal detecting and geocaching.
- Releasing or abandoning pets or wildlife.
- Climbing trees.
- Collecting firewood, plants, fish, wildlife, and any other natural or cultural resources.
- Feeding the ducks.
- Erecting signs, fences, barriers, and structures.
- Using the park for commercial purposes, public meetings, and assemblies without a permit.
- Distributing advertising materials or selling goods or services without a permit.

Pima County's Agua Caliente Park is a unique natural resource in a beautiful setting that makes it a great place to relax and enjoy family outings. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with the park usage information in this brochure for a truly wonderful experience.

PICNICS, REUNIONS, AND GATHERINGS

- Sites are not reservable. All sites are on a first come basis. Exception: Reservations are required for Easter.
- A Special Use Permit is required for all functions with 10–25 guests from November 1 – April 30 and all functions with 25–50 guests from May 1 – October 31. The permit is free. Stop by the visitor center or call 520-749-3718 for a copy of the permit application or download a copy at www.pima.gov/nrpr.
- A Special Use Permit does not guarantee parking or function location.
- Barbeques may only be fueled with charcoal or propane.
- No pop-up shade canopies allowed.

COMMERCIAL AND/OR PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY

- A Special Use Permit is required for professional photography. The permit is free. Stop by the visitor center or call 520-749-3718 for a copy of the permit application or download a copy at www.pima.gov/nrpr.
- Commercial filming requires special permitting and approval from Pima County Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation.
- Restrooms may not be used as changing areas.
- Posted "Restricted Areas" will be enforced.

WEDDINGS

- The maximum number of guests allowed is 25 from November 1 – April 30 and 50 from May 1 – October 31.
- A Special Use Permit is required and must be signed 14 days in advance. The permit is free. Stop by the visitor center or call 520-749-3718 for a copy of the permit application or download a copy at www.pima.gov/nrpr.
- A Special Use Permit does not guarantee parking or function location. Locations may not be reserved.
- Weddings must conclude before sunset.
- Services are limited to 2 hours in length.
- Soft music is allowed with prior approval.
- Areas not available for weddings: the Visitor Center, Rose Cottage, patios, and island.
- Strictly forbidden: alcoholic beverages, chairs, arches, canopies, carpet, balloons, confetti, use of the restrooms as changing areas, and vehicles beyond the parking lot.

Sites are not reservable. All sites are on a first come basis. **Upon arrival, please check in at the Ranch House.**

Permits are required for:

All functions November 1 – April 30 groups with 10–25 people, maximum of 25 guests.

All functions May 1 – October 31 groups with 25–50 people, maximum of 50 guests.

Any commercial use of Agua Caliente Park such as photography, filming, and magazine shoots require a special use permit.
