



Lifeguard Training Classes

American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Classes will be offered by Pima County Staff. Material covered will include American Red Cross Lifeguard Training (including First Aid, and CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer). **FEE: \$100.00 payable to Pima County NRPR. Cash or check accepted, please do not send cash in the mail.** Participants must be at least 15 years old to join the class (participants must be 16 years old to work for Pima County). There is a pre-requisite swim of at least 300 yards continuously (using breaststroke and freestyle) and 10 pound brick retrieval so please be prepared. **Fee is non-refundable**, but may be transferable to a later class. Class sizes are limited and are filled on a first come basis. Call Andrew Ivy at 520-877-6126 for more information and/or questions. In the event that the pool is closed due to weather or any other unforeseeable circumstance, the class may need to be extended to meet all objectives at the discretion of the head lifeguard instructor.
