Please be aware of the following revisions to the above referenced IFB.

- 1) **Replace:** the original Page 17 (17 of 17) with the following **Revised** Page 17.
- 2) Supplier Minimum Qualifications: Page 2 of 17 **and** Page 5 of 17.  
**Replace in their entirety items 1 and 2 in the original bid document with the following items:**
  - 1) All vendor employees and subcontractor employees shall have all required licenses /certificates including, but not limited to, Commercial Driver Licenses. Copies of CDL and other required licenses/certificates shall be kept on each employee's person to be produced upon request by County personnel.
  - 2) Vendors must be in the business of providing truck crane rental services with operators for at least two (2) consecutive years at the time of contract award. Valid copy(s) of vendor business license shall be submitted with bid response to meet this qualification.
- 3) Product or Service Specifications & Scope: Page 5 of 17  
**Replace in its entirety item 1 in the original bid document with the following item:**
  - 1) Vendor (crane & operator) must be on the job site within 24 hours after receipt of order or within a time frame determined and agreed to by both the vendor and the County.

All other specifications, terms and conditions remain the same. **IFB opening date and time remain unchanged.**
