ATTACHMENT A – MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS & DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS**Six (6) New Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV's) (current year model)****Minimum Qualifications:**

Vendor certifies that the firm, individuals acting for the firm, and all services and products provided pursuant to this agreement will conform to the following minimum qualifications and upon request will provide the documents requested for certifying compliance:

1. Vendor must be in the utility vehicle business for at least three (3) years prior to this IFB deadline. If requested by County, **proof** of this qualification shall be provided to County within three (3) days of the request.
2. Vendor must be an authorized distributor/dealer for the UTV manufacturer being bid to County. If requested by County, **proof** of this qualification shall be provided to County within three (3) days of the request.

Minimum Requirements:

1. UTV's shall be manufacturer's current model in production at time of delivery.
2. UTV's shall be new and unused. (Demonstrator models shall not be acceptable).
3. The warranty period shall be a minimum of one (1) year for both parts and labor. Warranty repair and/or replacement will be performed at no additional charge to Pima County. Warranty information shall be submitted with bid explaining the warranty coverage and defining specifically what is covered by warranty.

The following documents shall be provided to Pima County upon delivery of UTV's:

1. Manufacturer Statement of Origin (M.S.O.), which may include the odometer statement, if applicable. Unless otherwise ordered in writing, the M.S.O. shall show the owner/purchaser of the equipment as: Pima County Board of Supervisors, 1301 S. Mission Road, Tucson, AZ 85713
2. Invoice specifying the purchase order number and the serial numbers of the UTV's.

Specifications: Reference – Polaris Ranger 570 EFI (current year model) or equivalent. The UTV's must

- be able to *seat two adults* in a seat, each with a safety restraint.
- have a *utility or "truck style" bed*.
- have an *engine displacement of at least 567cc*.
- be capable of (AWD/2WD) *all-wheel drive or four wheel drive operation*.
- **have a wheelbase of at least 70"- 90"**.
- have a minimum *payload capacity of 1,000 pounds*.
- be powered by normal unleaded gasoline.
- have body panels that are a single solid color such as green, tan or white. Seats, etc., can be black or dark grey. County will finalize any standard color choices prior to award.
- have seatbelts and side nets
- **come equipped with the following: headlights, tail lights, brake lights, turn signals, 4 way flashers, license plate light, horn, and a mirror. Digital gauges such as speedometer, odometer, tachometer, trip meter, hour meter, gear indicator, fuel gauge, hi-temp. All lighting must be D.O.T approved. UTV's are to be provided as "street-legal", per the specifications listed.**

If the specifications of what you are bidding to County do not meet the specifications as listed herein you **must** supply a detailed explanation (separate sheet) of what you are bidding and how it will impact the end performance of the UTV's.

General Information:

1. Articles sold to Pima County are exempt from federal excise taxes.
2. Pricing shall be quoted F.O.B. destination. Unit Prices offered shall include all incidentals (any "other" fees) and associated costs required to comply with and satisfy all requirements referred to or included in this bid. Do not include tax in your unit prices.

Delivery:

Delivery shall be to: Pima County Fleet Services, 1301 S. Mission Road, Tucson, AZ. 85713-1312, Attn: Patricia Mehrens @ 520-740-5900 or Bob Charlton @ 520-740-2614 at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of delivery. All deliveries shall be made Monday through Friday from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The County will notify the successful bidder promptly of any damaged equipment and vendor shall make arrangements to repair/replace damaged equipment.

Pima County will need delivery of these UTV's by October 31, 2013, due to funding requirements.
