Sealed bids for construction of the Magee Road Improvements: La Cañada Dr. to Oracle Rd. (AZ77) (4MRLCO) project shall be delivered by the date and time indicated below to the Pima County Procurement Department offices located in the County Administration Building, 130 West Congress Street, 3rd Floor, Tucson, Arizona 85701. Bids must be accompanied by a surety bond of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

This project is located within Sections 25, 26, 35, and 36 of Township 12 South, Range 13 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Pima County, Arizona. The project consists of a total of 1.58 miles of road improvements including 1.35 miles of Magee Rd., from La Cañada Dr. to Oracle Rd., and 0.23 mile of Northern Ave. The construction consists of four lanes of roadway with medians, curbs, sidewalks, traffic signals, landscaping and irrigation, utility work and drainage facilities. This is a federally funded project and Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wages apply.

Estimated cost for the project is between \$11,000,000 and \$12,000,000. The project shall be complete and in place within 300 working days from the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages for late delivery will be assessed per Pima County Standard Specification Section 108-9.

All bidders will be subject to Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Registration and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements and reporting. Please review these requirements carefully. A minimum goal of 2.48% for participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's) as a percentage of the total amount of the bid award is established for this project. The requirement for On-the-Job Training is 1,500 total hours for 3 trainees.

The contractor must have the appropriate license issued by the State of Arizona Registrar of Contractors before award of the contract and maintain same through the duration of the project. Failure to obtain this license by the end of the sixtieth (60th) calendar day after bid opening may result in rejection of the bid without further recourse and award of the contract to the next low responsive, responsible bidder. Pima County reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to withhold the award for any reason.
