SUBJECT: USE OF 20-FOOT LENGTHS OF PVC PIPE

Based on the current supply of PVC pipe in standard lengths of 13 and 14 feet, the variance from Pima County Wastewater Management allowing the use of 20-foot lengths is now being cancelled. Local pipe suppliers have indicated that no supply shortage is projected, and that there are no existing orders or deliveries of 20-foot PVC for sewer projects.

This cancellation is immediate. If market conditions in the future require an assessment of material supply, we will make every effort to evaluate the impacts.
